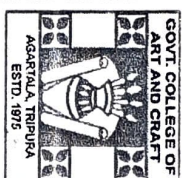

SYLLABUS FOR ONE YEAR(CERTIFICATE COURSE)OF
DECORATIVE ART

The Govt College of Art & Craft offers a ONE YEAR CERTIFICATE COURSE in DECORATIVE ART .The Course Structure is designed by the College. The entire Course is divided into four subjects and there is a one final examination in the end of the year. The detail Course structure is as follows:

One Year Certificate Course:

Full Marks - 400+200 = 600

Rules & Regulation for the One Year Certificate Course in Decorative Art:

Duration of Studies: One Year.

Eligibility Criterion for admission:

1. No candidate shall be allowed to be admitted to the Certificate course until he/she has completed the 16 years of age.
There is no upper age limit for Certificate Course.
2. The Candidate must have passed the Madhyamik (10th standard) Examination or equivalent Examination from TBSE or any other recognized Board.
3. The Govt. College of Art & Craft shall arrange for the Common Admission Test(CAT).Admission shall be made on the basis of performance in the CAT.
4. The intake capacity in certificate Course is forty.

Examination System:

1. Each paper shall carry 100 marks.
2. To be eligible to appear at the Final Examination each student shall have a minimum 75% of attendance in the classes.
3. If a student having attendance of 65% and above but less than 75%, he/she shall be declared as a non collegiate.
4. A non-collegiate candidate shall have to pay non-collegiate fee, along with other fees at the time of filling up of the Examination forms.
5. A student who has attended less than 65% classes shall be declared as dis-collegiate. Such candidate shall not be allowed to appear the Final Examination. However, he/she may take re-admission to the Course subject to availability of the seats and on payment of requisite fees.

Result:

1. In Certificate Course, passing out in four practical subjects in the Final Examination on (i)Design,(ii)Batik,(iii)Tie&Dye,(iv)Alpana are compulsory.
2. Each subject is graded out of full marks of 100.
3. There are no Theory subjects in this course.
4. Students have to clear their Sessional works having 200 marks, which depends on Internal Display of the year round works of their classes.(Internal Examiner100+External Examiner100).
5. Total Marks of this Course is 400+200=600 .Pass marks is 40%. 1st Division-360 (60%), 2nd Division-300(50%), Pass marks-240 %(40%) .

Examination shall be held according to the syllabus.

Note: The Exact date of the Sessional Examination shall be fixed by the College. The College Authority shall announce The result of the Final Examination.
